Archbishop Responds to Royal Commission Revelations

Western Australians had an absolute right to demand that the Church confront its appalling record in relation to the care and well-being of the young, Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SDB said this week in response to revelations from the Royal Commission into Institutionalised Responses to Child Sex Abuse.

Archbishop Costelloe said that the shock and disgust in relation to statistics on child sexual abuse in the Catholic Church in Australia was palpable, justified and confronting

"Each incidence of sexual abuse by a priest represents a chilling and destructive betrayal of everything the Catholic Church purports to stand for," he said.

"Those within the Catholic Church and those outside it are asking how this revolting and insidious evil could have been so prevalent, so long unacknowledged, and so badly handled.

"In the face of the overwhelming pain of those who have suffered abuse, I may not always have been able to respond as they needed me to. For that I am deeply sorry. I have done and will continue to do my best.

"You have a right to insist that we show, not by words but by concrete and effective actions, that we are absolutely committed to doing everything we can to make every Catholic community, agency, and activity, a place of security and safety for the young.

"I once again pledge myself, and to the extent that I can the whole Catholic community, to continue to make this our absolute priority."
