The from May the 27th. 50th anniversary of the 1967 referendum that saw over 90% of Australians vote to give the Commonwealth the power to make laws for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and recognise them in the national census. It ends on June 3rd the 25th Anniversary of the High Court of Australia's landmark Mabo decision in 1992, which legally recognised that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples have a special, a relationship to the land, a relationship that existed prior to colonisation and still exists today. This recognition paved the way for land rights or Native Title. This year's theme Let's Take the Next Steps and is about all Australians being part of the next big steps in our nation's reconciliation journey.
